WSC Ice Show: FAQ

- When is the show?
 - o This year, the Woodville Ice Show will take place on Saturday March 23rd, 2019. There will be two shows, one at 12:00pm, and one at 4:00pm.
- Is my skater(s) in the show?
 - o The Woodville Skating Club would like to emphasize that ALL skaters regardless of their skating ability are welcome to participate in the show. We love to provide all of our skaters an opportunity to show off the skills that they have gained throughout the year.
- What should my skater(s) wear?
 - o Costumes will be put together by members of the WSC executive and will be handed out to our skaters between March 13th and 15th. These packages will have details regarding what costume to wear when, and if there is anything that may have to be brought from home (ie. A white t-shirt).
- Is there a dress rehearsal?
 - o Yes. Dress rehearsal will run from approximately 5:15pm to 6:50pm on Thursday, March 21st. We encourage as many skaters to come as possible.
- Who is in charge of my child during the show?
 - o Although the WSC executive does it's best to keep all of the skaters organized, we unfortunately do not have enough people to ensure every skater is dressed with their skates on for their time to shine. Due to this we ask that parents take responsibility for ensuring their skaters are dressed with skates on at least 15 minutes before they are to skate.
- Should I bring anything?
 - o If you'd like to bring snacks for your skaters to have throughout the show you may. As well, we encourage parents to bring blankets to keep warm as the heaters in the stands do not work in the third section.
- How can I help?
 - o As a small club, we appreciate any and all help from parent volunteers. The ice show is a large production that would not be possible if not for the hard work of the executive and volunteers.
