SKATER LEVELS

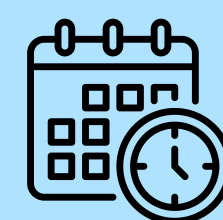
We've made some changes, our Silver STAR Session this year will be for skaters who are STAR 1, STAR 2 or STAR 3.



PROGRAM PERKS

This session will be fully coached, meaning that our coaches will be providing group lessons to all skaters as well as floating, to ensure that all skaters can get the assistance that they need, when they need it. Coaches will also be able to encourage skaters to keep active while on the ice, leading to a better quality program overall.

Note: No private lessons will be offered on this session.



PROGRAM SCHEDULE

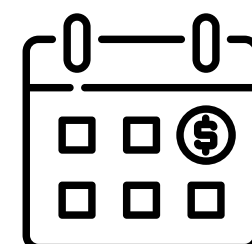
Our Silver STAR Sessions will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning on September 10 and running until March 13. Two nights/week will be mandatory for all skaters.

Tuesdays: 4:30 PM - 5:30 PM

Thursdays: 6:25 PM - 7:20 PM

PAYMENT PLANS

The WSC offers payment plans for all of our programming. The basic structure is that all fees (Admin, Skate Canada and Fundraising) + 30% of registration fees are due at the time of registration. The remaining registration payments can be spread out over the next 4 months. DID YOU KNOW?



On average, a parent will pay an additional ~\$400.00 per season for private skating lessons (1 private lesson per week). The WSC has decided to change its session format to be fully coached in an effort to make the sport more affordable in the long run, as well as more accessible to all skaters. The coaches will be fully paid by the WSC, and will provide coaching to all skaters throughout their sessions, therefore, eliminating the additional cost of private lessons from parents. Skaters will have time to work independently, but a coach will be available to assist and make corrections. You may note that the registration fees have increased this year - this is reflective of our ice fee increase of 3.25%, as well as the changes made as described above.
